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Another few kilometers away is Mantalai, and it is believed that Lord Shiva had got married to the Goddess Parvati here. On the way to Sudh Mahadev, a short link road takes one to Krimchi, a site with three of the ancient temples around Jammu. The whole architecture reflects the distinct Greek Influences.

## AQUARIUM & BAGH-E-BAHU

A Fascinating Garden on the foot hills of Bahu Fort, a beautifully landscaped and lush green garden on the bank of river Tawi called BAGH -E - BAHU is worth a visit. You can enjoy boating in the artificial lake created inside the garden. The Garden offers splendid views of the Jammu City and is an ideal picnic spot. Novel way of spending

your leisure and memorable time. If you happen to be there in the evening musical fountain will enthral you. One must visit aquarium inside the complex.

## SHIV KHORI

85 Kms from Katra. This ancient sacred cave, almost a kilometer long with a 4 feet high naturally formed Shivling (Aap Shambu) can be reached after a trekking of 3 kms from the place of it's base camp called Ransoo, along a scenic route. This pilgrimage can be easily done by you after Darshan of Mata Vaisnodevi as it is an extension route on the same road of Jammu Katra through a place called Reasi. This cave is the most intricate having no end and is a real unique one in the whole of India among all caves.
